This home is located on a 60-foot-wide infill lot on a street lined with 1950s bungalow cottages in Fredericksburg's historic district. To allow for as much usable outdoor space as possible, the project focused on a completely different housing arrangement than what is typically found on the adjacent streets.

Moving the home to the back of the lot and framing the L-shaped plan allows for a true courtyard living experience and expands the home's usefulness for the moderate, yearround climate. Its eastern orientation allows prevailing breezes to enter the courtyard over the pool and in turn passively cool the home during the warmer months.
